MOTION TO CORRECT SENTENCE

NOW COMES the defendant, by and through legal counsel, and moves this Honorable Court pursuant to Rule 35(c) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure for an order correcting the sentence imposed in this matter at a hearing on May 20, 1993, and in support of this motion shows unto the court the following:

1. The offense conduct for which the defendant was originally sentenced occurred in 1989.

2. The defendant was originally sentenced in 1989, but was resentenced on July 28, 1992 to three and one-half (3 1/2) years in the custody of the Bureau of Prisons, followed by three (3) years supervised release.

3. At the hearing held on May 20, 1993, the court, upon finding that defendant violated the terms of his supervised release, used and relied upon the guidelines set forth in Chapter 7, specifically 7B1.4 of the United States Sentencing Commission Guidelines Manual, to determine the sentence to be imposed.

4. Chapter 7 of the Sentencing Guidelines was not effective until November 1, 1990, and applying the guidelines to defendant's case

would be an ex post facto application.

5. That application of said guidelines in this case was clear error.

WHEREFORE, defendant requests that the judgment and sentence imposed as a result of the hearing on May 20, 1993 in this matter be stricken and that a new hearing be held in this matter.
