MOTION TO DELAY REPORTING TO PRISON

The defendant, [REDACTED] hereby requests to delay his reporting date to prison currently scheduled for February 15, 1996, to March 15, 1996.

The Court revoked defendant's supervised release on January 4, 1996, and sentenced him to ten months imprisonment. The Court ordered that the defendant report to the United States Marshal for this district at 12:00 p.m. on February 15, 1996, in Greensboro, North Carolina.

The undersigned has received word that defendant has experienced a recent death in the family and his mother-in-law is seriously ill and his wife is having to care for her. To report on February 15 would create undue hardship on the family and defendant is requesting to report a month later.

The undersigned has conferred with [REDACTED] of the United States Attorney's Office and he neither opposes nor consents to any delay in reporting.
