

The Defendant, by and through his/her attorney, respectfully moves the Court for an order pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4284 and 28 U.S.C. § 1651 authorizing transportation and subsistence expenses for him/her for his/her court appearance on (enter date) in _____, North Carolina.
