MOTION TO TERMINATE PROBATION

The defendant in the above case previously pleaded guilty to the offense of willful and unlawful failure to pay past due child support in the amount of \$6,927.43. The defendant appeared for sentencing on June 26, 2000, and was placed on probation for a term of five years, with a restitution order directing him to pay the amount of \$6,927.43 in monthly installments of \$100.00 per month during his term of probation.

The defendant now has paid off the entire amount of restitution, as evidence by the Court record attached hereto as Exhibit A. Based on the defendant's extraordinary efforts to make full restitution, the defendant respectfully requests that his term of probation be terminated, since the primary reason for being placed on probation was to supervise his restitution payments.
